Human Table Football	Over enthusiastic participants	Responsible person to supervise at all times Supporting spectators must not lean over wall due to risk of being stuck by players and / or ball	2	2	2	If event has a large attendance more supervisors should be supplied to assist
Human Table Football	Over crowding	Responsible person to supervise at all times One person per station. Cords should be waist height on user Supervisor to start game Entry and exit unit via goal area	1	1	1	Reinforce number of user's guidelines
Human Table Football	Danger of falling from height	Responsible person to supervise at all times Climbing, hanging, sitting on walls is prohibited	1	1	1	None
Human Table Football	Adverse weather	Equipment not to be used in high winds over 24mph (includes gusts) and during heavy rain	2	2	1	Quarantine unit from use or deflate until conditions improve
Human Table Football	Injury from hard surfaces	Use on a grassed area using industry standard stakes Use approved thunder bolts on hard standing and use matting Use sand bags indoors and use matting	1	1	1	None
Human Table Football	Injury from poor supervision	Responsible person to supervise at all times Do not use without adequate supervisors present	1	2	2	If event has a large attendance more supervisors should be supplied to assist
Human Table Football	Tripping over anchor points / auxiliary equipment	Anchor points installed to manufactures guidance. Additional equipment stored away. Power cables to be positioned /covered appropriately	1	1	2	None
Human Table Football	Injury through incorrect positioning	Equipment installed correctly in a safe position. Never attempt to reposition the unit	-	-	-	None
Human Table Football	Choking	No foods / chewing gum / drinks allowed on the equipment	1	2	1	None
Human Table Football	Third party injury	Remove shoes, eye glasses, jewellery, badges and lanyards. All drinking containers to be positioned away from play areas	2	2	2	None
Human Table Football	Historical injury	No user should have a history of back or neck problems, have heart issues, is pregnant, is under the influence of drugs /drink or feeling unwell	1	2	1	None
Human Table Football	Inflation with combustion engine/gennie	No Smoking. Spare fuel to be located in a locked store. Fencing installed around plant area.	1	2	1	None
