COVID-19 Appendix

The following Covid-19 measures will be implemented to prevent spread and contraction, to the best of our ability.

Stunt Shows:

- Team to social distance to the required government guidelines.
- Use of facemarks whenever working inside or in close proximity to others.
- Each member of the team to be issued with their own personal set of tools and equipment.
- Alcohol hand gel to be used before and after using any equipment that has been used by others.
- Alcohol hand gel to be used whenever leaving or entering our performance area.
- Masks to be worn whenever talking to members of the public from a safe distance.
- Anyone with Covid-19 symptoms before the event will be removed from the job and replaced.
- Anyone displaying Covid-19 symptoms during the event will be asked to leave.

Participation features:

- Team to social distance to the required government guidelines.
- Face masks to be worn by all staff at all times.
- Adults entering the area with their children will be asked to wear masks.
- Each member of the team to be issued with their own personal set of tools and equipment.
- Alcohol hand gel to be used before and after each participant.
- All participants will be required to alcohol gel their hands before entering the participation area.
- Every bike to be wiped down after each use. This includes handle bars, brakes and seat.
- Participants are encouraged to use their own cycling helmets.
- Borrowed helmets will be wiped down before and after each use.
- Any staff with Covid-19 symptoms before the event will be removed from the job and replaced.
- Any staff displaying Covid-19 symptoms during the event will be asked to leave.
