		Only hand balloons to adults.

		Ensure we are aware of allergies through health forms	
Injury from balloon being stretched or popped	Young people, adults, performer	Only stretch balloons away from participants	
		Adult supervision at all times	
Ingestion of balloon / choking	Young people	Only hand out inflated balloons	
		Adult supervision at all times	
		Dispose of popped balloons immediately	
Injury from balloon pump	Young people, adults, performer	Point balloon pump away from face whilst inflating balloons. Maintain safe distance from young people	
		Ensure balloon pump is out of access of young people	
Damage to ear drums when popping balloon	Young people, adults, performer	Maintain safe distance when inflating balloons	
		Do not over inflate balloons	
		Advise young people to not intentionally pop balloons near others	
		Adult supervision at all times	
PA system (S&E provided) - trips / falls	Young people, adults, performer	Keep wires short and out of way of participants	
		Advise participants to stay away from equipment	
Choking on sweets given as part of performance	Young people	Minimise activity involvement whilst eating, everyone encouraged to stay sat down	
		Many leaders will have First Response training, with additional support from on-site First Aid	
Magic box, stand, PA system - knocked over or bumped into	Young people, adults, performer	Placed out of way of young people
