| Lifting & Carrying | Helpers | Boxes and items can be heavy, care should taken when lifting. Only do what is in your own ability safely and get help if needed. Care when lifting, posture and position to do so safely. | |
| Errection/Dismantling of Shelving | Helpers | Shelving needs to be erected and dismantled. Care to be taken with individuals building/dismantling shelving and to seek assistance where needed to ensure it is done saftely and within the capability of individuals. | |
