Hazard	Who Might Be Harmed	Is the Risk Adequately Controlled, or is More Needed	Review and Revision
Trips and falls while moving around the tent and secured	Everyone	Lighting will be adequate to prevent trips. Floor coverings etc will be assessed when set up and secured if necessary.	
Heightened mood	Everyone	Area to be supervised by Inclusion Team or another nominated individual. In the event of a Scout or adult being in distress, they will be taken to the quiet area, away from the rest of the group. In the event that their behaviour escalates, the tent will be evacuated of all but the core Inclusion Team who will calm the person down. Inclusion team are knowledgeable in de-escalation techniques and in the absence of a person who knows the Scout, they will take the lead.	
First Aid	Everyone	All groups are expected to supply their own first aid kits and have at least one leader with a valid first response certificate. The event will supplement this with a medical tent (and first aid posts during the Main Event) for second opinions and more serious injuries.	
Mental Health First Aid	Everyone	There are people on site who have Mental Health First Aid Training and these names will be available to the core team in Chill.	
Fire	Everyone	Clearly defined fire exits will be laid out. Designated fire points, with fire extinguishers, within 50m of any tent. Electrics will be tested by a trained professional unless new.	
Access to scissors and sharp instruments	Everyone	Chill team will be in charge/supervising all the activities. Usual risks from using scissors, paper etc. Scissors will be put away each evening and kept under control of the Chill Team adults. Chill tent will be supervised at all times whilst open.	
Difficulty in communication while accessing Chill Tent	Young People	List of participants who may need to access area coming from joining instructions. Flash cards for Chill Helpers to aid communication.	
Hot drinks in the 18+ Chill area	Everyone	Adults do not leave the area unless their beverage is in a sealed container	
Hammock chairs tipping	Everyone	Hammock frames will be secured with rebar stakes to prevent tipping. Rules of use will be displayed.	
Injury from shade tents	Everyone	Tents will be secured with pegs. In strong wind, they will be removed from use and put away.	
Injury from sensory regulation/toy	Everyone	If a TP needs to use big movements or large sensory toys, they will be taken outside the front of the Chill tent and supervised in a clear space.
